## ADVISORY ON PHILIPPINE PASSPORTS USED AS COLLATERAL FOR LOANS OR OBLIGATIONS

Pursuant to Foreign Service Circular No. 214-99 of the Department of Foreign Affairs, **Philippine Passports** that are reported as being held by another person as **guarantee or collateral for loans/obligations** are **automatically cancelled** upon notice from or by the holder(s) of the said passport(s).

The cancellation of the passport(s), therefore, renders the passport(s) **INVALID FOR THE PURPOSE OF GUARANTEEING PAYMENT OF LOANS/ OBLIGATIONS.** 

The Philippine Embassy in Phnom Penh reminds all Filipinos in Cambodia that Philippine Passports are the property of the Government of the Republic of the Philippines and shall not be used, at any time, as collateral for any loans/obligations.
